Correspondence and Informational Items: Thank you card from a resident, who expressed appreciation for responding to fire call on their property. Received Notice of Trustee's Sale on Agave properties on Reed Street. Elkhorn Fire District being contracting out fire service.

- Informational items and reports- Chief Jones shared he is working with Harbour Apartments to correct their emergency alarm system. Assistant Chief Vogl presented the Annual 2024 calls. He reported there were 297 calls as of the end of 2024. There were 155 EMS calls, 142 Fire calls which included 31 calls to Robbins. Still using current system for January.
